From Phenix City: Take 431/280 North toward Opelika, Go past K-Mart to Next Traffic Light. Turn right on Opelika Rd to Lee Rd.240. Take Left on Lee Rd. 240, go to four way stop. Take right onto Lee Rd 179. GO about 1/4 of a mile to Lee Rd 244. Take right, follow road around and look for pond of the left. Take first paved drive-way on left after pond.

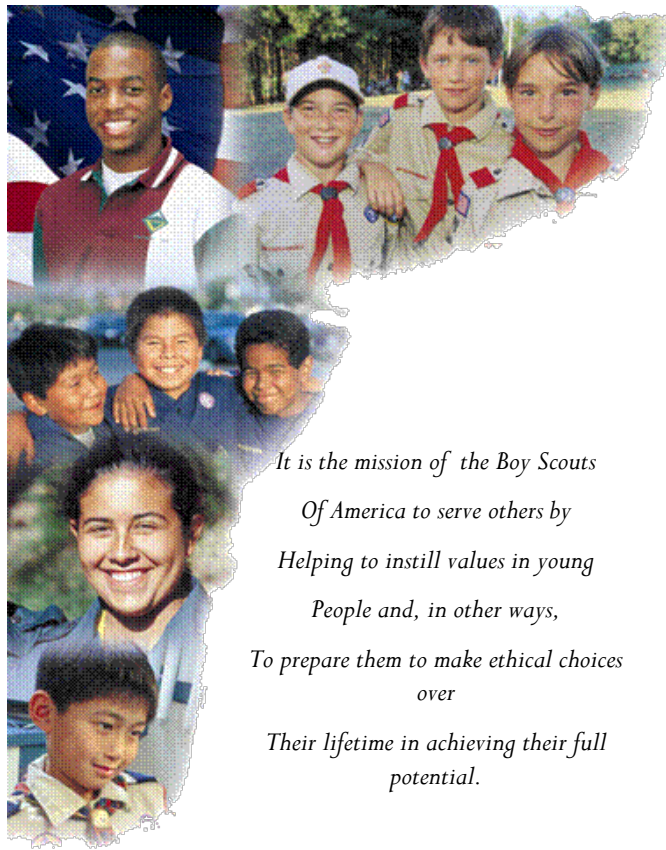
