PROGRAM

The purpose of Cub Scout Day Camp is for all Cub Scouts and Webelos to learn and advance in rank while having FUN! **All 1st Grade Tiger Cubs must have an adult partner with them for the entire week no exceptions!**

STAFF & VOLUNTEERS

Day Camp is staffed entirely by parents and volunteers. **WE NEED YOUR HELP!** We request one leader per 5 youth from each unit. **To assist with your non-camper children while you volunteer, each camp has a special Pixie program to entertain your younger children while you are working on staff.**

When you volunteer, you will be sent an application and will be contacted by the Camp Director to attend Day Camp Staff Training. **Pixie Camp** is not available at **Auburn Camp**.

ELIGIBILITY

To attend any of the Day Camps, a boy must be a registered Cub Scout. Boys who are not presently Cub Scouts may participate but must pay an additional \$10 fee which will also be applied to register the boy with a Cub Scout Pack.

ACCEPTANCE

Most camps have limited space and fill quickly. You will be notified if your camp is full upon receipt of your registration.

CUB SCOUT RANK

Most of the Day Camp programs are based on the Cub Scout's rank. It is important that we know what grade your boy will be entering in the fall of 2008. Those entering:

- 1st Grade will work on Tiger achievements
- 2nd Grade will work on Wolf achievements
- 3rd Grade will work on Bear achievements
- 4th Grade will work on Webelos I achievements
- 5th Grade will work on Webelos II achievements

WHAT TO BRING AND WEAR

Boys should wear the Day Camp T-Shirt, blue shorts, socks, and closed-toe shoes (**Sandals are not allowed**).

All campers must bring a non-perishable sack lunch (except on Friday or last day – when lunch will be provided).

Insect repellent and sun screens are a MUST!

Each scout must be instructed in the proper application of sun screen and insect repellants **prior** to attending camp.

Boys should wear swimming trunks and bring a towel on days when Aquatics activities are scheduled, as noted in your confirmation letter after registration.

Put your son's name on everything that comes to camp, even his lunch!

- **\$10.00** extra for **Extended Care** for youth
- There are no fees for adults or volunteers.

EXTENDED CARE

Childcare will be offered at all camps (excluding **Camp Cowpie & Auburn**) daily. The cost is \$10.00 per child for the entire week.

CAMP T-SHIRTS:

The registration fee includes one T-shirt. Adult Staff and volunteers who attend Day camp will receive a free T-shirt. Additional T-shirts may be ordered in advance at \$8.00 per shirt, except Adult XXL & XXXL which are \$10.
