Rules/Regulations

- **Parking will only be allowed at the Administration Bldg. No OFF Road Parking or Driving Vehicles into Campsites or onto Activity Field**
- **Upon arrival you will be able to drive your gear to your campsite and/or on the side road of the Activity field (stay off the grass), but it must be returned to the parking lot immediately after unloading.**
- No Fires are allowed directly on camp grounds. All fires must be elevated off the ground in cooking equipment such as grill, propane gas stove, etc. No dumping of charcoals on camp grounds.
- All garbage will be disposed by the unit. No burning of trash.
- The campsite cannot be altered in any way by the group using the site such as digging holes, building ax yards, pioneering projects, moving of tables, making or carving on any wood surfaces, etc.
- All units/individuals will agree to be responsible for and pay the cost of any damage to camp property.
- It is the responsibility of the unit to leave the campsite clean upon check-out on Sunday.
- Do not exceed the speed limit of 10 miles per hour in Camp.
- Passengers are strictly prohibited from riding on the rear deck of any vehicle.
